

FIESTA INFORMATION SHEET

PLACE: Lakeville South High School, 21135 Jacquard Ave, Lakeville, 55044

DIRECTIONS: From I-35, exit at County Highway 70 (exit 81). Go east on Hwy 70, and turn left (north) on Jacquard Ave. The school is on the left side of Jacquard Ave.

TIME: show **6:00** p.m. (NOTE TIME CHANGE), children arrive at **5:30** p.m.

We hope that the show will last no more than 2 hours. Meeting that schedule depends on the show starting on time. Please be on time, especially if your child is in the first 3 groups.

Please note that the auditorium holds 1000 people and we have approximately 1200 people attending if every child brings 2 persons to the show. It is a fire code violation to allow people to stand in the aisles. To make sure that every parent has a seat for the show, share a seat with a small child and please bring only immediate family.

COSTUMES:

For all campers in grades 1-6. You should accompany your child to the costume room (see map on back) and help your child into his/her costume and make-up. Please do not leave shoes or other non-costume clothing in the costume room or in the hallways. Take these items with you to your seat. Please make sure your child uses the bathroom before you drop him/her off in the auditorium. After your child is in costume, **DROP OFF YOUR CHILD** in his/her designated seating area in the auditorium (see map on back). Your child's teacher will be sitting in the designated seating area and will remain with your child until your child's dance is completed. After your child's performance, you may either pick up your child in the hall way outside the stage (see map on back) or you may pick up your child in the designated seating area. A monitor will sit with your child until the end of the program or you pick up your child. Do not tell your child to meet you anywhere except as above.

For all campers in grades 7-12: Your child should be in costume and sitting in the designated area (see map on back) throughout the performance. If your child needs additional supervision, you will need to sit with your child. We will not provide monitors for this age group.

IF YOU NEED TO LEAVE EARLY: Pick up your child in the hall between the stage and auditorium door (see map on back) or find your child in the designated seating area (see map). Please do not tell your child to meet you anywhere else because the monitors will ask them to remain in their seat until an adult picks them up.

REFRESHMENTS: After the program, water and cookies will be served in the main lobby.

QUESTIONS?: Fiesta volunteers will be wearing neon yellow colored shirts the evening of Fiesta to help answer any questions and assist in making the evening fun and successful!
