

FIESTA 2010 INFORMATION SHEET

PLACE: Lakeville South High School

Lakeville, MN 55044

DIRECTIONS: **From I-35:** exit at County Highway 70 (exit 81)
Go east on Hwy 70, and turn left (north) on Jacquard Ave.
The school is on the left side of Jacquard Ave

From All Saints Church: Turn right (south) on Holyoke Ave.
Go right (west) on 210th St. and turn left (south) on Jacquard Ave.
The school is on the right side of Jacquard Ave.

SHOWTIME: **5:30** p.m. - all dancers should arrive at **5:00** p.m.

Please note that the auditorium holds approx. 1,000 people and we have 1,200 people attending if every child brings 2 guests to the show. It is a fire code violation to allow people to stand in the aisles. To make sure that everyone has a seat for the show, please share a seat with a small child and limit the number of people you invite to the show.

CAMPERS IN GRADES 1-6

COSTUMES: Please refer to the confirmation mailing you received in early July for costume requirements. You should accompany your child to the costume changing room (see map) and help your child into his/her costume and make-up. Please do not leave shoes or other non-costume clothing in the costume room or in the hallways. Take these items with you to your seat. Please make sure your child uses the bathroom before you drop him/her off in the auditorium.

WHERE TO DROP OFF YOUR CHILD: After your child is in costume, take your child to his/her designated seating area in the auditorium (see map). Your child's teacher will be sitting in the designated seating area and will remain with your child until your child's dance is completed. After your child's performance, you may either pick up your child in the hallway outside the stage (see map) or you may pick up your child in the designated seating area. A monitor will sit with your child until the end of the program or you pick up your child. For safety reasons, do not tell your child to meet you anywhere except as noted above.

CAMPERS IN GRADES 7-12

Your child should be in costume and sitting in the designated area throughout the performance. If your child needs additional supervision, you will need to sit with your child. We will not provide monitors for this age group.

IF YOU NEED TO LEAVE EARLY: Pick up your child in the hall between the stage and auditorium door (see map) after they complete their dance or find your child in the designated seating area (see map). Please do not tell your child to meet you anywhere else because the monitors will ask them to remain in their seat until an adult picks them up.

REFRESHMENTS: After the program, water and cookies will be served in the main lobby.

FIESTA DVDs: If you did not order a DVD at the time of registration, there will be an opportunity to order them during camp and the night of the event. The cost is \$20 per DVD. Check or cash form of payments only will be accepted. DVDs will be mailed once production editing is complete.
